John GEFFREY

Stow in Lindsey is not in the immediate Horncastle area; but a few miles NW of Lincoln

John bap. May 2nd 1562 Stow in Lindsey
Elizabeth bap. May 2nd 1562 ditto
Peter bap. Dec. 4th 1563 ditto
Robert bap. Oct. 2 7th 1565 ditto

There are other JEFFEREY families in the county at this time, e.g. around Boston, Sleuford, Grantham and Skellingthorpe, etc.



St Wilfred's, Thornton by Horncastle

(Katherin WINSER and Elyn WINSER also married at Thornton, both in 1575 and Robert was baptised there in 1571)

b.c. 1540

William JEFFRYE = Francis WINSER
bur. Sept. 10th 1586 Moorby

Oct. 28th 1566 Thornton by Horncastle

b.c. 1567
Francessa JEFFRAY = Robert SMYTHE
October 2nd 1587 Moorby

(Is this the Robert SMYTHE who was baptised at Horncastle on June 19th 1568?)

(A Dorothy JEFFRAY married John MEDLEY on June 29th 1613 at Heckington, about 16 miles from Marcham)

(Edward and William were almost certainly brothers or at least cousins. Martin and Thornton by Horncastle are less than a mile apart.)
Since William did not marry until 1566 it is perhaps more likely that Thomas and Anne were Edward's children, born at Martin in the 1550s before Frauncys, whose baptism was the very first in the St Michael register.

Joane had brother John b. 1562
Thomas 1564 and Elizabeth 1565
so she presumably born before 1561.
