Thomas TYRWHITT who married Anna HERSTE at Arksey in 1567 has still to be identified; but one possibility, that he might be the Thomas TYRWHITT born circa 1536 to father Philipp TYRWHITE of nearby Barton upon Humber who died in 1558, can be discounted. Philip's widow Margaret refers to her son Thomas in her will of 1591/2, by which time 'our' Thomas had been dead some fifteen years.

Thomas and Joan TRYVYE (bur. Aug. 21st 1586) had a daughter Elizabeth bap. March 10th 1585, bur. March 12th 1586/87

At Adwick le Street:

Anna TROUGHETT bur. Ap. 6th 1587
William TRORTHWETT? bur Ap. 28th 1587

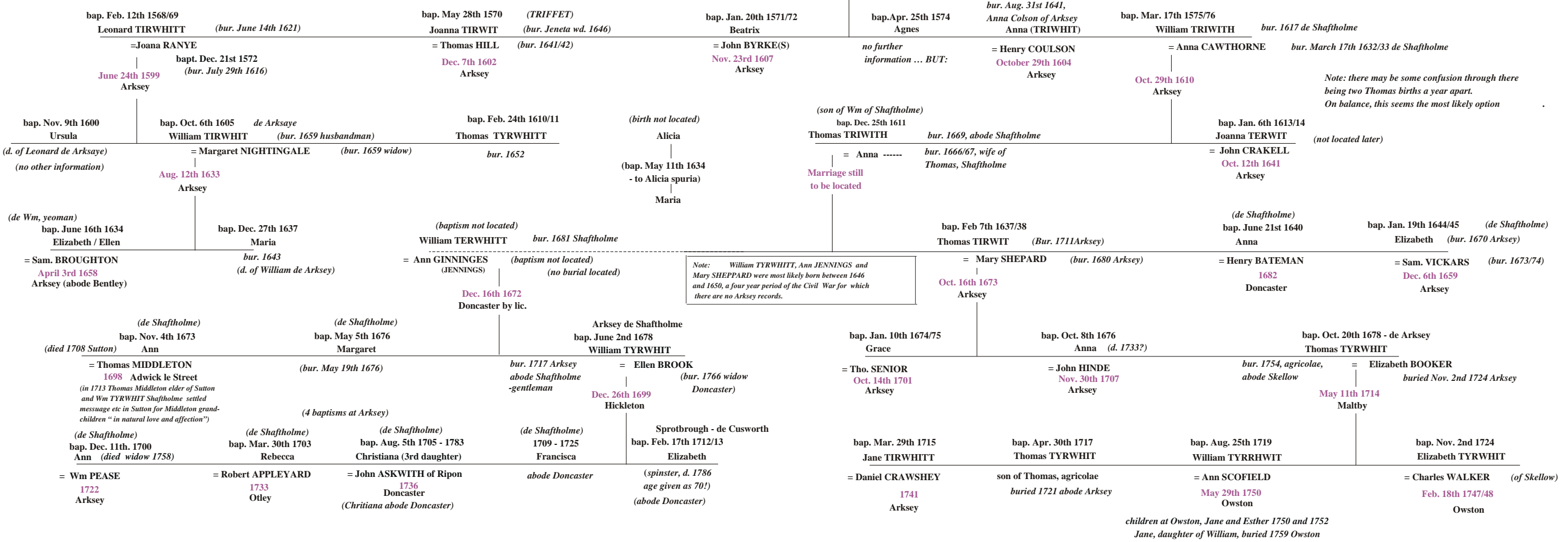
John TURWHIT = Isabel
bur. Nov. 10th 1597 TRIFFETT | bur. Nov. 29th 1595 (TRYFETT)

these records parish of Sprotbrough

bap. Nov. 16th 1561 Francis TYRWHIT | bap. Feb. 20th 1563 John TYRWHYT | bap. Nov. 30th 1567 Mary TYRWHYT
bur. Oct. 7th 1590 (son of JohnTRYFFYT) | ? bur. Dec. 16th 1564 TRUGHET

And in Doncaster:

bur. Nov. 10th 1617, Mawdlyn TREWHITT wife of Richard buried May 17th 1618, Richard TREWHITT milner



Note: there may be some confusion through there being two Thomas births a year apart. On balance, this seems the most likely option

Note: William TYRWHITT, Ann JENNINGS and Mary SHEPPARD were most likely born between 1646 and 1650, a four year period of the Civil War for which there are no Arksey records.
